#### <u>Overview</u>

Each year the 420 Class (via Selection Committee) selects teams to attend the World Championships and Junior Europeans. In 2025 selection will be needed for the following events:

- 1. 420 World Championships Urla, Turkey (1st 9th July 2025)
- 2. 420 Junior European Championships Porto, Portugal (20th 27th 2025)

### **Selection Series**

The Teams will be selected in Spring 2025 (refer to 2025 Selection Policies on class website). The Selection events are:

- 1. 1st Selection Event 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> March 2025 Inland Championships, Rutland Sailing Club
- 2. 2nd Selection Event 29<sup>th</sup> & 30th March 202 Spring Championship, Royal Southern
- 3. 3rd Selection Event 14<sup>th</sup> 18<sup>th</sup> April 2025 RYA Youth Nationals, Plas Heli

#### **Team Size**

Unlike some other youth class boats, only the top sailors from each country can attend these events following a selection series.

Each country is given an allocation of the number of boats, with a guaranteed number of places. For boats to qualify for the U17 places, both helm and crew must be 16 or under at the end of the year in which the championships take place. **Note**: the age of the boat will be based on the age of the oldest sailor in the boat.

The split of boats for 2025 is as detailed below (please refer to the individual Selection Policy for the confirmed allocation):

World Championships: 8 Boats – with the following as a minimum

- the highest ranked U17 pair
- the highest ranked mixed pair
- the highest ranked female pair
- the highest ranked male pair

NOTE: the RYA has communicated their intention to support BYST boats at this event.

#### **Logistics**

The logistics of getting boats and sailors to the events is always challenging. 2025 is going to be no different given the geographical locations of the events and the time frames between each event. This event is particularly complex as it involves large distances and travel outside of the EU. Therefore we are expecting costs of transporting boats to be higher than usual. The cost will also vary enormously dependent on team size. Any costings given within this document are purely intended as an approximate guide.



The Class has the following assets which will be available for the Teams to hire:

- 6 boat stacker trailer x 2 (1 may be converted to a trailer taking 8 boats)
- 4 boat stacker trailer + rib space
- 2 boat stacker trailer + rib space
- Class rib

We know that a number of parents have triple/double stacker trailers that may be able to be used depending on the number of boats that need to be transported. The Class will take the lead on helping the team with the logistics but parents will be expected to assist with transporting boats. Parents will also need to consider whether they have a vehicle that is appropriate to tow these trailers.

**NOTE:** charter boats may be available at the venue - these would need to be booked and paid for directly by parents. These charter options are made available to non European sailors first, and therefore we expect that it is unlikely a GBR sailor would easily secure a charter boat. Based on previous events charter costs are likely to be circa £175 per day.

It is the intent to use the ferry from **Trieste to Cesme** for this journey. This is a RORO ferry which will take trailers and vehicles, but not passengers. A carnet and support from a customs import adviser is suggested by the International class to facilitate this. The GBR class will look into this when team size is confirmed. Driving the boats overland is not deemed as desirable due to the length of the route and the security of some of the countries that will need to be driven through en route.

**FURTHER NOTE:** it is predicted that boats will not have returned from Turkey in enough time to allow training ahead of the Junior Europeans in Porto. Teams wishing to attend both events will need to consider this. A second boat to support the training period in Porto would be a possible solution.

The 2025 World Championships will be held in Urla, Turkey

#### (1st to 9th July 2025)

This map shows both Cesme (West) which is the ferry port and Icmeler (East) which is the venue. Urla is the nearest town and is further East.

Driving time from Cesme to the venue is around 45 minutes.
