2. Review of Previous Actions

2.1 Summer Event Selection Policy

 Status: Ian Walker has shared drafts with the selection committee. Still awaiting confirmation from the RYA regarding the Youth World Selection Policy.

2.2 Trailer Insurance and Claim

O Discussion:

- Tom reported no response from the Italian party responsible for the trailer accident.
- Tom drafted a letter threatening legal action with support from David Davies.
- Identified gaps in trailer insurance, requiring a review.

2.3 QR Code for Sailor Registration

o Report: Completed and in use.

2.4 French and German Invitations

Status: Not yet drafted—Gareth to follow up..

2.5 Social Events Feedback

 Report: Positive feedback from the Grafham event, especially among new sailors, who appreciated the buddy system and social integration.

3. Key Agenda Items

3.1 International Events:

- o Palamós event preparations underway: trailers being packed, airport transfers confirmed, and coach entries pending.
- Discussion on a generic knowledge base for customs paperwork to be hosted on the website.

Action Points:

- Tom to finalise and share the customs document on the website with restricted access.
- Sharon to test event-specific access control for website content.

3.2 Technical and Equipment Updates:

- Trailer Upgrades: Discussions on converting a trailer to hold eight boats for cost efficiency.
- Technical Guidelines: Ongoing discussions with the RYA and 29er class on the use
 of technology in training and racing. Key focus on cameras, wearable devices, and fair
 application of technology.

Action Points:

- Gareth to set timelines for technical recommendations before the 2025 selection events.
- Ben to continue exploring on-board camera usage guidelines for training and racing.

3.3 Training and Sailor Development:

- Strong participation at recent training sessions. Positive feedback from new sailors on coach support.
- Proposal for webinars or team calls to educate sailors on protests, arbitration, and rules before major events.

Action Points:

- Gareth and Mark to organise a mock protest webinar to educate newer sailors.
- Record the session for accessibility to those unable to attend live.

3.4 Social Media and Promotions:

 Jeremy actively promoting events on platforms like Facebook and Instagram to increase visibility.

o Action Point:

Sailor reps to assist with resharing promotional posts.

3.5 Class Constitution and Youth Worlds:

- Concerns raised regarding potential conflicts between RYA training camps and the class constitution's focus on international events.
- Agreement to align selection policies with long-term goals of the class, while supporting RYA objectives.

 Gareth to follow up with Ollie regarding timing for the Youth World Selection Policy.
